### ACADEMIC CONTENT

Overall objective	<p>A specialisation course aims to allow students to immerse themselves in the theories/theory lines and empirical issues pertaining to a particular subject area. The course equips students to competently select and argue for the applicability and relevance of a theory/theory line to given issues. The courses offered are based on the Institute's research in the field and knowledge of the highest international standard. The specific subject area of the courses will be described in the activity description.</p> <p>Current Global and Development Challenges and Solutions addresses various global and development challenges, such as conflicts, questions of justice, inequality, sustainability, and effects for instance on states, markets and civil society.</p>
Detailed description of content	<p>"What is contemporary humanitarianism and to what extent does it have a politics? This course investigates the nature, history and politics of global humanitarianism, studying the phenomenon at the local, regional and global levels. It seeks to understand the concept of humanitarianism and the practices, institutions and laws to which it has given rise, including practices which alleviate suffering and pathologies which exacerbate it. Focus is also on contemporary problems, the actors in the humanitarian field, and the way in which they create and navigate the humanitarian field, including South-South collaborations.</p> <p>The course consists of 13 classes, including several by practice-oriented or specialist guest lecturers. It has three parts. The first part investigates the concepts, history, theory, and law of global humanitarianism. The second studies different levels and types of humanitarian actors, such as local, regional, South-South, and global political organisations. The last part applies knowledge from part 1 and 2 to four specific cases and hotspots in Africa, Asia and the Middle East.</p> <p>The course builds your academic skills by asking you to understand and discuss academic knowledge about humanitarianism. It also includes a focus on policy analysis in the humanitarian sector and requires you to produce a policy paper. Lastly, the course aims to connect you with practitioners in the field by inviting them to share their experiences through guest lectures. "</p>
Course material and Reading list	<p>The readings consist of academic journal articles and book chapters from a range of fields, including international studies, international politics, development studies, and refugee studies. The required and optional readings will be listed on the course Moodle site in due course.</p>
