ACADEMIC CONTENT

Overall objective

The objective of this course is to familiarize students with theories of social innovation processes, social change theory and sustainable transitions that takes place between multiple stakeholders including a variety of enterprises and organizations. Emphasis will also be placed on the role of management in promoting and organizing social innovation

and entrepreneurship processes. During the course students will be introduced to concepts, theories and methods and learn to apply them in analysis of challenges and development of solutions in relation to social innovation and social change in real-life cases from the private, public or third sector.

Detailed description of content

The course engages with social innovation theories and methods. It introduces to the field of social innovation theories and concepts and go in-depth with key themes, such as bricolage, value co-creation and co-production, social value, sustainability and the relationship between social innovation and social change. It also introduces and applies innovation process methods such as design thinking, participatory processes and collaborative learning.

Overall learning outcomes

After completing this course, students will be able to:

- Assess and analyse how social innovation processes are linked to macro and micro actors.
- Assess and reflect upon how different actors and resources can be mobilised and organized for social innovation.
- Develop and critically evaluate solutions to practical real-life challenges in case organizations in the public, private or third sector.

Form of examination

Group portfolio and oral exam

Permitted group size: 3-5 students. Examples of written products are exercise responses, talking points for presentations, written feedback, reflections, written assignments. The preparation of the products may be subject to time limits.

The character limits include the cover, table of contents, bibliography, figures and other illustrations, but exclude any appendices.

Time allowed for exam including time used for assessment is for:

3 students: 50 minutes. 4 students: 60 minutes. 5 students: 70 minutes.
