#### ACADEMIC CONTENT

# Overall objective

A practice-oriented methodology course aims to equip students to competently apply a given technique or tool that is frequently used in practice.

The course equips students to argue for the applicability and relevance of the technique or tool to the problem, and to apply the technique or tool in work situations.

# Detailed description of content

This course introduces and teaches basic legal thinking. The aim is for students to learn to carry out legal reasoning in relation to the solution of specific policy issues. Students should learn to identify, interpret and apply legal frameworks for political practice in concrete situations. Additionally, students are trained to identify, find, interpret and use relevant sources of law, with a focus on international law and EU legislation. The course thus trains students to relate rules to practical problems in order to propose solutions to policy problems. The purpose here is to give suggestions on how a legal framework can be understood and interpreted if there are several possible outcomes, as well as to establish what the legal position is when there is clarity about the outcome. The course includes training in reading legal documents, i.e. judgments. In addition, the course provides an introduction to critical jurisprudential and legal sociological analysis of a policy field.

#### Course material and Reading list

The course has no assigned book. The syllabus will be built on articles and book chapters, available in the library or provided by the professors. Information regarding assigned materials will be posted on Moodle.ruc.dk

#### Overall plan and expected work effort

The class meets 10 times, where students should participate actively including by reading the assigned literature. This equals 135 hours of student work, which consists of: Preparing for and attending lectures: 6 hours each, 60 hours total Preparing questions assigned for each class meeting: 1 hour, 10 hours total Other (for example, preparing class presentations): 5 hours Preparing the portfolio exam: 70 hours
