Overall objective	The course introduces students to key theoretical and conceptional discussions about development and globalisation. It provides a historical basis for understanding the contemporary global situation via the study of global social, political and economic processes since the 19th century

The second part of the course focuses on contemporary academic debates about global and development challenges such as climate change, intersectionality, class, gender and race, inequality, conflict, populism, human rights and global flows.</p>
Detailed description of content	<p>"The course is structured into three blocks</p> <p>The first block engages historical dimensions and conceptual debates of globalisation and development.</p> <p>The second and third blocks introduce key contemporary challenges to the field of globalisation and development through the introduction and application of theories while grounding it in historical and conceptual debates. (Block headings could be: 'Power and inequality' and 'Post-development and global futures').</p> <p>After the first two parts students hand in the written product and receives feedback.</p> <p>"</p>

They acquire knowledge about the historical background to today's academic and political debates about global distributions of wealth and power, global flows of media, culture, ideas and knowledge, environmental change and conflict.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Through lectures and class discussion, students learn to analyse politics, economics, and society globally and to situate development historically. Their assignment and oral exam must demonstrate an overview of the main theories and approaches, and their ability to apply these theories in relation to current global problems.
Form of examination	<p>Individual written portfolio and oral exam</p> <p>The character limit of the portfolio is 12,000-14,400 characters, including spaces. Examples of written products are exercise responses, talking points for presentations, written feedback, reflections, written assignments. The preparation of the products may be subject to time limits.</p> <p>The character limits include the cover, table of contents, bibliography, figures and other illustrations, but exclude any appendices.</p> <p>Time allowed for exam including time used for assessment: 30 minutes. The assessment is an overall assessment of the written product(s) and the subsequent oral examination.</p> <p>Permitted support and preparation materials for the oral exam: All.</p> <p>Assessment: 7-point grading scale Moderation: External examiner</p>
