Type of activity	Mandatory course
Form of examination (p1)	<p>The course is passed through active and satisfactory participation.</p> <p>Active participation is defined as: The student must participate in course related activities (e.g. workshops, seminars, field excursions, process study groups, working conferences, supervision groups, feedback sessions).</p> <p>Satisfactory active participation is defined as: - The student must during the course hand in a portfolio consisting of maximum 10 written products (the exact number is determined by the lecturer), which combined must not exceed 36.000 characters including spaces. - The student must during the course participate in a feedback-session.</p>

Assessment: Pass/Fail.

Form of Re-examination
(p1)

Individual written take-home assignment in a research question of own choice approved by the lecturer.

The character limit of the assignment is: 24,000-28,800 characters, including spaces.
The character limit includes the cover, table of contents, bibliography, figures and other illustrations, but exclude any appendices.

The duration of the take-home assignment is 7 days and may include weekends and public holidays.
The estimated work effort is 20 hours. Other exams may therefore be scheduled simultaneously.
